The Procurement and Controls Department of Richmond Public Schools consists of a Director, Charles Ward, a Sr. Purchasing Officer, Melinda Williams, and three (3) Purchasing Officers, Alma Bell, Davonia Holland and Darlene Thomas, and an Administrative Office Associate, Sheila Battle, who performs administrative support tasks for the department and subordinate divisions as required.



The Property Management Division consists of a Supervisor, Damone Harris, and a Property Specialist, Dennis Lampley.

The Department is responsible for the procurement of all materials, equipment, construction, supplies, professional and non-professional services; property management controls, conducting surplus sales and maintaining a complete centralized purchasing and distribution program; and formulating the basic policies and procedures to be use in exercising procurement functions throughout the district.
